Review of MAPs Assessment Data</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We shared the overall percent of students that fell into different percentile categories for the fall MAPs tests in Math and Reading. We compared the 2020 data to their fall 2019 data. While not ideal because fall MAPs is a pre-test and we do not have any spring data from last year or this year yet, we did note from this data that we aren't seeing any alarming trends in the data based on the shift to remote learning last spring.
