School Accountability Committee Meeting

Our third quarter School Accountability Committee (SAC) meeting will be held on **Monday, February 23, from 3:30 - 4:30 in the Kinard Media Center**. The Kinard School Accountability Committee meets four times per year, approximately quarterly. The SAC is a wonderful opportunity to enhance our partnership with parents through an organized group composed of both parents and teachers at Kinard. The SAC has a very specific focus, established by the Colorado Department of Education and Poudre School District. Primary topics for analysis and discussion will include budget allocation and Kinard's Unified Improvement Plan (UIP). Other topics that may be discussed in this committee include but are not limited to: parent involvement, student transitions, curriculum, instruction, assessment, systems for support, communication, technology, leadership, decision-making, positive behavior support, and school-wide capacity building. We welcome any parent to attend our next meeting, even if you were unable to join our previous meetings.

2026 CMAS Assessment Window

Please mark your calendars! The 2026 CMAS Assessment window is April 6th - 23rd. All students will take 3 English Language Arts assessments and 3 Mathematics assessments. Additionally, 8th graders will take 3 Science assessments. Please see the calendar below for a tentative schedule for when each of these assessments will occur. As you plan ahead, we would greatly appreciate you doing your best to avoid appointments or other student absences on these days.

The state assessment system, Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS), is designed to measure student mastery of Colorado's academic content standards. Colorado's academic content standards indicate skills and knowledge necessary to prepare students for success from early school readiness to postsecondary competencies, reflective of both workforce readiness and 21st century skills. Student progress toward these outcomes is measured through CMAS, which provides information to teachers as they incorporate the content standards in their daily instruction. CMAS results are also used for school and district accountability.

Student Scooters

For several years, we have been able to allow students to bring their scooters (electric or otherwise) inside to store them throughout the school day. Unfortunately, we are no longer able to sustain this practice. We have made a change, effective Monday, January 26, and all scooters must be parked outside. We have an increasing number of scooters that are brought inside and parked in the music hallway. We can no longer provide the space in the hallway to accommodate the number of scooters each day. Moving forward, all students should park and lock their scooter to a bike rack outside. We announced this change to students in late January.

In addition, we also took time to remind students who ride a bike, skateboard, or scooter to school each day to use the sidewalks when they are on school property. We reminded them to stop and get off of their bike, skateboard, or scooter once they are on the sidewalks connected to the school. We want to avoid and/or minimize the opportunity for accidents. We have observed many students on their bikes, skateboards, or scooters riding too fast next to cars or students walking.

School Threats: What to Do if Your Child Witnesses One

In this day and age, we unfortunately hear and see a lot of disturbing things, whether it is in person, on TV, or on social media. We can sometimes forget that our children often see these things as well. We wanted to remind parents of best practice surrounding what to do if you hear or see something that isn't right, but more specifically school threats.

In most cases where there was a school shooting, there was some sort of warning that the suspect would give. In years past, it usually came through a social media post. Kids tend to engage on social media apps that some adults may not, giving them a unique way to view information that adults may not have. It is important to talk with your kids and make sure they know it is safe to talk to you and other adults about these topics.

The message we tell everyone is "[see something, say something](#)". Each student should know how to access Safe2Tell, which is an anonymous tipline. These tips come directly to your student's School Administrative team, SRO, and our 911 Dispatch Center. Because there can be a lag in time to respond to Safe2Tell, we ask that if it is emergent and there is an imminent threat to the school, tell the SRO immediately or any adult in the school. If it is outside of school hours, please call 911.

We take all threats to our schools very seriously, whether it is a joke or real. If your child happens to witness this, please talk with them about reporting and gathering as much information as possible. Taking screenshots or videos of the information is very helpful to SROs in identifying and contacting the person posting. Keep in mind that if you choose to report on Safe2Tell, we cannot reach out for more information unless you provide it within the tip, as it is anonymous. Providing as much information as possible is key in preventing these catastrophes from happening. School safety is the responsibility of all of us; it takes a team. Thank you for your time and cooperation with keeping our kids safe!
