Student Leadership: Kinard C.A.R.E.S. Service-Learning Trip

In November, the Kinard C.A.R.E.S. leadership class traveled to Catalina Island to participate in an environmental leadership program off the coast of California. Students in this class are focused on a vision of raising environmental awareness while making a difference in their local community. The aim of the class trip to Catalina Island is to provide students with authentic and engaging learning experiences that reflect the civic responsibilities that the students will face as citizens in the real world.

While on the island, students engaged in an experiential-based outdoor learning curriculum that taught them important principles about the environment. Using one of the most diverse ecosystems on the planet as their classroom, students explored a local watershed and cove and learned about healthy ecosystems while developing interpersonal leadership skills.

While the trip was filled with recreation and adventure, it was far from a vacation. Students participated in a variety of service-learning projects to enhance the Catalina Island community. Students built trails and planted

Season's Greetings! Let's delve into the important topic of cell phone safety, especially relevant if your student is either about to get a cell phone or already has one. Parents often wonder about monitoring their child's phone, and here are some key points to discuss with your child:

- 1. **Digital Permanence:** Emphasize that everything they write or post online remains accessible forever, including on social media platforms.
- 2. **Cyberbullying:** In case of cyberbullying or encountering inappropriate content, advise your child to confide in a trusted adult. Have continuing conversations!
- 3. **Caution with Unknown Contacts:** Instruct them not to add unfamiliar individuals on social media and to be cautious about answering calls or texts from unknown numbers.

4. **Parental Involvement:** Communicate! Establish a regular schedule, perhaps weekly, to go through the phone together. This provides an opportunity to discuss any concerns and check for signs of cyberbullying, grooming behavior, inappropriate content, or unfamiliar apps.

For additional safety measures:

- **Social Media Settings:** Explore and implement the parental supervision available on various social media platforms.
- Parent Control Apps: Consider using parental control apps that allow you to block content and monitor your child's activities directly from your own device.

While we cannot shield our children entirely from technology and social media, we can empower them with the tools to navigate these platforms safely and responsibly. If you have further questions, feel free to reach out. We are here to support you and your students!

On October 10, students in the Give Next class went to CSU for "Kickoff Day." These Kinard students did an excellent job representing our school at

nonprofit workshops and interacting with local community leaders to learn more about philanthropy and their opportunity to improve the lives of those in need in our community. With over 20 other schools in the Give Next program attending Kick Off, this was an inspirational day to set the stage for the rest of the Give Next experience.

What is Give Next?

Give Next is a school-based youth grantmaking program for middle and high school students in Larimer County. Each class receives funding from private donors in the Give Next program for grant-making to award to local nonprofits. The students are also encouraged to participate in



fundraising to make a larger positive impact in their community. The yearlong program begins with Give Next Kickoff Day, a day of information and inspiration. Back at their schools, students work together to identify community needs, choose a focus area, create a mission statement, research nonprofits, volunteer, conduct site visits, review grant applications, and make funding decisions. At the end of the school year, students award grants to selected nonprofits. Give Next is made possible through the support of many community partners. Primary program implementation partners are Bohemian Foundation and the Community Foundation of Northern Colorado.
