Congratulations, SciO Mustangs and a huge thank you to Ms. Blumberg for leading the program this year!

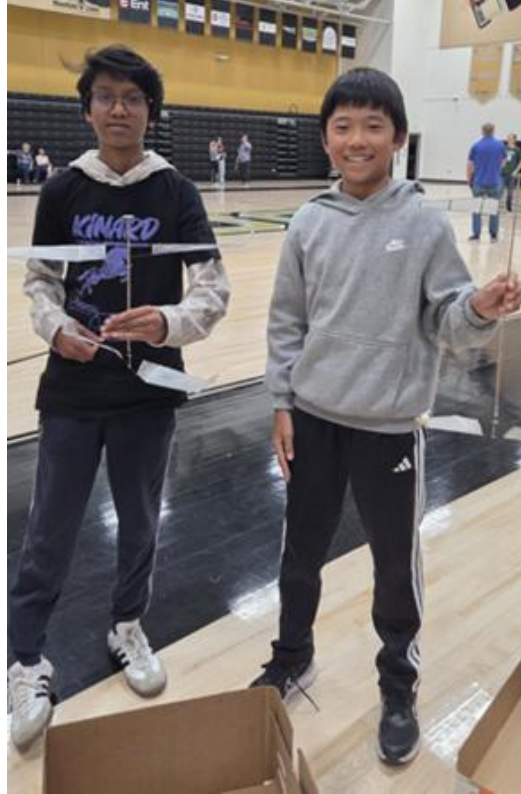

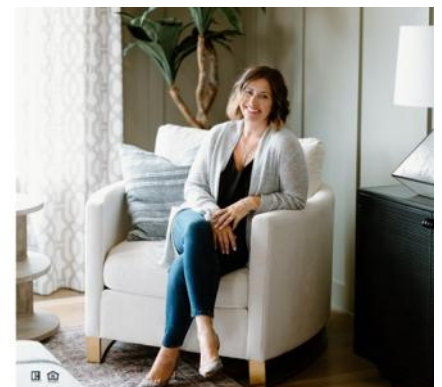

Orchestra News

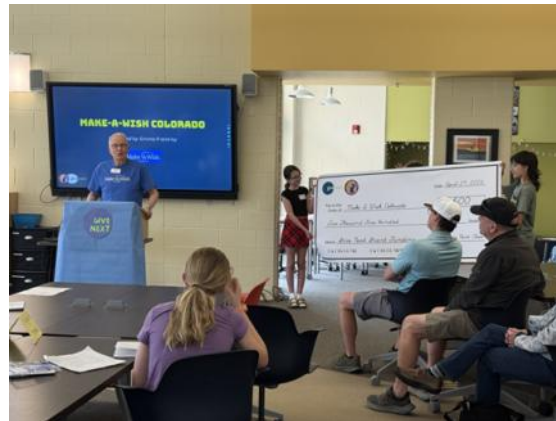
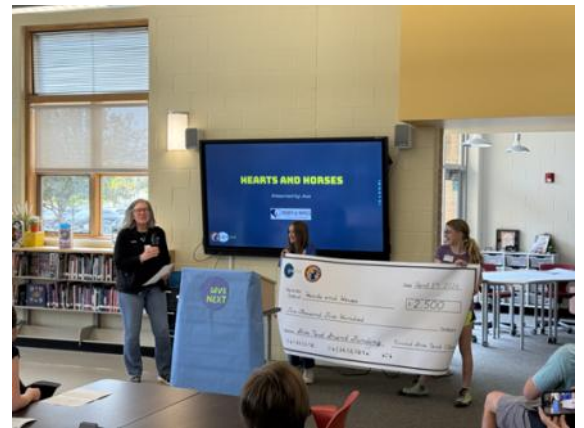

Give Next Grant Awards

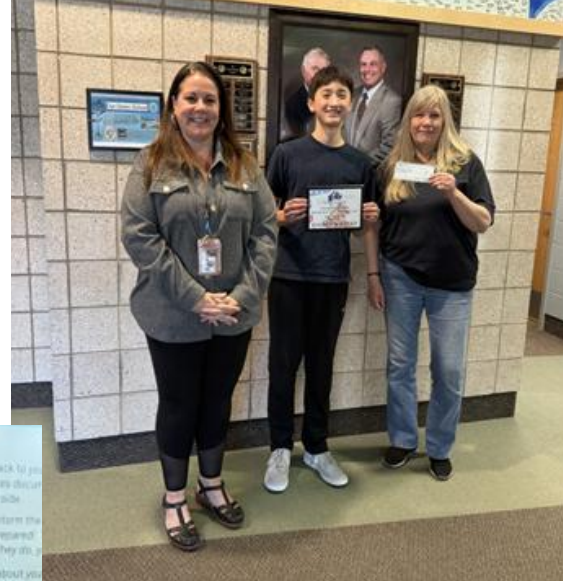



Technology Check-In: May 20 & 21

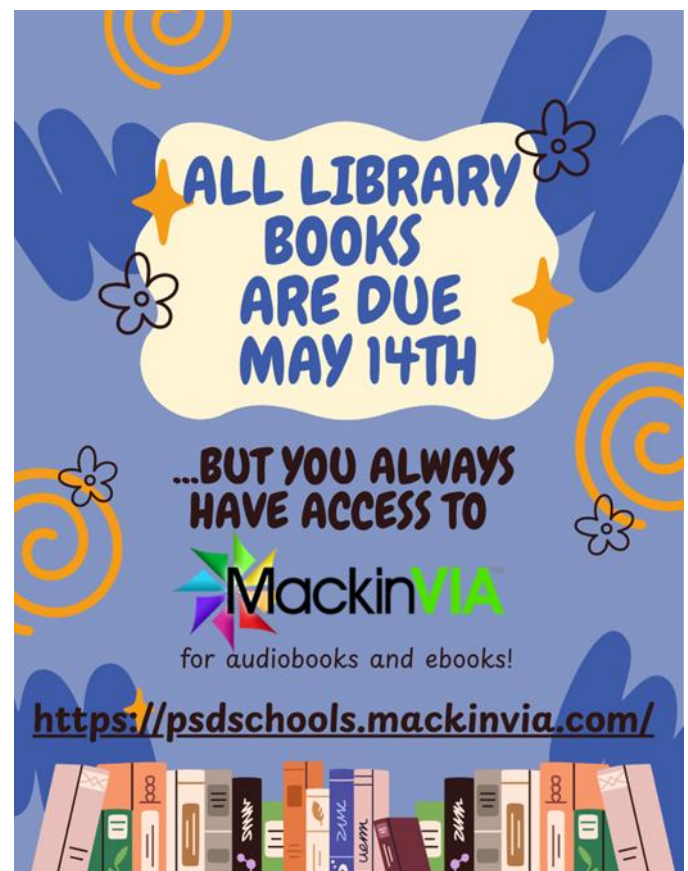

This past school year several schools have seen an uptick in safety incidents involving students riding e-bikes and e-scooters. I wanted to remind parents and students that it is important to wear helmets while riding e-bikes and e-scooters. It is also important to obey all traffic and bicycle laws while riding any electric transportation (this includes controlling the speed of the e-bikes or e-scooters!). Kinard Health Office: End-of-Year Reminders

With the end of the year in sight, we want to ensure we keep our students healthy and focused on finishing the year strong. This all starts with...

- Eating a good breakfast- either at home or reminding your student there is free breakfast served at school every morning from 7:45 – 8:15 AM.
- Drinking plenty of water throughout the day.
- Getting plenty of sleep, especially before any formative/summative.
- Keeping students home when sick:
 - ◇ We ask that students stay home if they have had a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or excessive coughing within the last 24 hours.

- ◇ Students must be **24-hour fever, vomiting, or diarrhea free** before they can return to school.
- ◇ This helps with recovery and stops the spread of illness, protecting the school community.

Medication Collection Reminder

We are in the home stretch to the end of this school year. This is another reminder for Medication **Collection**. The health team sent out an email regarding pick-up information earlier in April.

- The Last Day of school is **Wednesday, May 27**, which is a ½ day. **ALL** medications must be collected by 11:00 AM on that day unless another time has already been discussed.
 - ◇ Please reach out to the health team if there is another time that you need to collect, but all medications must be collected no later than 11:40 which is dismissal on May 27th.
- Medications **CAN** be collected **anytime between now and May 27th**. If daily medications are picked up before the last day of school, the number of pills needed for the rest of the year can be counted out and kept in the original container at school.
- Parents must collect the medications; **NO MEDS** will be sent home with the students.

Summer Running with Coach Hebert

This summer Coach Hebert, the Kinard Cross Country Coach, is working to build a network of all Kinard students who are interested in running and fitness. Students who participate in any summer activities will need to be enrolled at Kinard for the 2026-2027 school year.

Kinard Cross Country will meet at **The Harmony Transit Center**, which is located on Harmony Road just west of I-25. Workouts will start at 6:30 p.m. and last for an hour. Workouts will be designated for a variety of running abilities, from new beginners who have run very little before to high level runners. Workouts are free of charge and optional! No athlete evaluation will be conducted at these workouts and there will be no impact on placement for any team sport.

These workouts are intended to be **FUN** and **Social!** This will be a good time to hang out with your friends and meet some new friends that will be fellow Mustangs in the fall, while remaining fit for the fall sports season.

Week 2: Football IQ development (rules, situational awareness, offensive/defensive structure)

Week 3: Controlled walkthrough installations emphasizing alignment precision and cadence discipline

Session II (July 14 – August 6, 2026 | Tues/Wed/Thurs | Time TBD)

Following a four-week gap, Week 1 of Session II will function as a structured reset and reinforcement week. From Day 2 forward, sessions return to a standard install rhythm focusing on:

Core run and pass concept implementation

Situational football understanding

Controlled execution and leadership development

Each 90-minute session is structured to include classroom instruction, guided walkthroughs, controlled reps, and accountability debriefs.

The program is supervised and conducted by the Kinard Middle School Football coaching staff.
