2025 CMAS Assessment Window

Please mark your calendars! The 2025 CMAS Assessment window is March 31 – April 25. All students will take 3 English Language Arts assessments and 3 Mathematics assessments. Additionally, 8th graders will take 3 Science assessments. Please see the calendar below for a schedule for when each of these assessments will occur. As you plan ahead, we would greatly appreciate you doing your best to avoid appointments or other student absences on these days.

The state assessment system, Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS), is designed to measure student mastery of Colorado's academic content standards. Colorado's academic content standards indicate skills and knowledge necessary to prepare students for success from early school readiness to postsecondary competencies, reflective of both workforce readiness and 21st century skills. Student progress toward these outcomes is measured through CMAS, which provides information to teachers as they incorporate the content standards in their daily instruction. CMAS results are also used for school and district accountability.

SRO Corner

Firearm Safe Storage & Safety: What You Need to Know

While owning firearms is a right, it comes with serious responsibilities, including ensuring that your weapon is stored safely to prevent unauthorized access, accidents, and theft. Whether you're a seasoned gun owner or new to firearm ownership, practicing safe storage and handling is critical for protecting yourself, your family, and your community.

Safe Storage Practices

- 1. **Use a Gun Safe or Locking Device** Store firearms in a locked safe, gun cabinet, or secure storage case. For an added layer of security, you can use a cable lock or trigger lock.
- 2. **Store Firearms Unloaded** Always store guns unloaded, with ammunition stored separately in a locked container.
- 3. **Educate Household Members** Ensure that everyone in your household understands firearm safety, especially children. Teach them never to touch a firearm without adult supervision.
- 4. **Secure Keys and Combinations** Keep safe keys or lock combinations in a separate and secure location to prevent unauthorized access.
- 5. **Be Mindful of Firearm Transportation** When traveling with firearms, ensure they are secured in a locked case and comply with all transportation laws.

Colorado Firearm Storage Laws

Colorado law requires that firearms be securely stored when not in use to prevent access by unauthorized users, particularly minors. Under Colorado law, it is illegal to leave a firearm accessible to a juvenile or someone prohibited from possessing firearms if the weapon is not stored in a secure manner.

Colorado recently added laws to storing firearms in a vehicle. They now must be stored in a locked container if the vehicle is left unattended.

Additionally, firearm dealers in Colorado are required to provide locking devices with each firearm sale.

The Importance of Safe Storage

Proper firearm storage helps to prevent tragic accidents, suicide, and theft. According to national statistics, many unintentional shootings occur in homes where firearms are not stored securely. Safe storage is one of the most effective ways to reduce these risks and ensure that firearms do not fall into the wrong hands.

Get Involved in Firearm Safety

- Consider taking a firearm safety course to stay up-to-date on best practices.
- Learn the current laws where you live regarding storage.
- Encourage other firearm owners to practice responsible storage.

By following these safety measures and adhering to Colorado law, you can be a responsible firearm owner and help create a safer community for everyone.




